1. Applications must be returned to Guidance Counselors by Friday, April 23, 2021. **Any late scholarship applications will not be considered.**
2. All applications must be **accompanied by a high school transcript.**
3. Scholarship decisions will primarily be based on academic records. Financial need, attendance, and extracurricular activities will also be factors for consideration.
4. **All scholarship applicants must enter the field of education.**
5. All applicants must have a minimum **cumulative 3.0 GPA** in order to be considered for the Gallia County Retired Teachers Association (GCRTA) Scholarship.
6. Scholarship funds come from interest earned on Scholarship Savings Accounts; therefore, the amount of scholarships awarded will be determined by the GCRTA treasurer.
7. If all criteria are met, the scholarship committee will award one scholarship to one student at each of the following schools: South Gallia High School, River Valley High School, Gallia Academy High School, and Ohio Valley Christian School.
