Blended Attendance Procedures, Policies and Consequences:

As a student enrolled in S.O.D.A you will adhere to the following guidelines:

___ I understand that I must secure and have access to a computer with internet connection to complete my school work.

___ I understand that additional school supplies may be required per subjects. It is the parent/student's responsibility to collect those items.

___ I understand that I will ask my teacher for assistance if I do not understand the concept, assignment or anything associated to the course. As well as answer any communication in a timely manner from any staff at SODA.

___ I understand that a selected time has been set up to communicate with each teacher at the home school. No other time will be allowed, except scheduled hours.

Parents

___ I understand that if my child is not performing and completing the required work my child will fall under truancy issues, which will be my responsibility to comply with the officer.

___ I understand that I will answer any correspondence from SODA in a timely manner.

___ I understand if determined by the SODA staff that your child is eligible for special education he/she will be assigned an intervention specialist/case manager that you can communicate with. I also understand that I will have to attend yearly IEP meetings for my student.

___ I understand that I must keep all personal information updated with SODA.

___ I understand that all shot records need to be up-to-date and presented to SODA.

___ I understand that full participation in all mandated state testing is expected on the required dates and at the required location (to be determined).

Attendance/ Hours Policy

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SODA

requires a minimum of 25 weekly hour's online completing courses through Pearson Connexus or Edmentum, with great progress. There is no exception to the 25 hours a week rule. This is a state requirement.

1. Consequences of not completing your weekly hours:

1st offense

- I. Make up your hours. You have 1 week to complete time.

2nd offense

- II. If you do not complete step 1 you will be required to have a meeting with the SODA staff. Parent and student are required. The meeting will be via Google Meet/Zoom/telephone conference to develop a plan to stay in the program.

3rd offense

- III. Meeting with administration and SODA team to revalue the plan and possible removal from the program and return to home school.

- 2. You are required to complete a total of at least 920 blended hours. Students are required to log 5 or more hours per day, five days a week. This can be any day of the week. You can log no more than 10 hours a day.
- 3. If for any reason you need time off, you will be required to present a doctor's excuse. That will need turned in within 2 days of your absence from hours.
- 4. Not having internet is not an excuse. If your internet is down, you need to secure internet from another location; including the SODA center Rio/ Allen Hall. University of Rio Grande.
- 5. Please note that SODA blended program is not the least restrictive environment for students of special education.
